OLD BUSINESS:

- Rezone parcel 52-08-27-401-030.000-016, commonly known as 121 E Canal from I-1 to
 I-2
 - Petitioner re-canted request changed name to remove recycling from their name and so no longer believes there is a need for a zoning change to I2. Business dismissed.

NEW BUSINESS

 Partial alley vacation located between parcel #52-08-27-217-009.000-016 commonly known as 202 E 8th and parcel #52-08-27-217-008.000-016, commonly known as 214 E 8th.

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Petitioner Ron Wilson explained that a few years back one side of 8th St was closed to parking and they have been parking in the alley since.

They want to close this section of the alley for parking purposes. Joe Molyneux explained that if they decided to fence off any of the alley that



was vacated that Peru Utilities would need to be able to access that area. Mr. Wilson explained they do not want to put up fencing. A neighbor spoke, just stated he wanted to make sure the entire alley isn't being closed. Ron Rylands asked if emergency services could get through and it is confirmed that they can enter from the north end if needed. Discussion about making sure parking was only in the designated vacated ally. The board approved the recommendation unanimously.

• Discuss ordinance 151.064 Lot sizes.

Discussion of board for the lot sizes for single dwelling on community sewage. Ron Rylands stated he checked with surrounding cities, Greensburg and Martinsville, 2 classes above Peru as cities, on the size of their lots. 6,000 and 8,000 respectively. He believes that the proposed

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size of 4,000 sq feet is too small. Joe Molyneux stated that the average size of the lots in Peru are 4,000 sq feet and this would allow people to build a new home on an existing lot in town. Patricia Russell stated that the homes could be small or built up. Dave Moon asked if homes could be



built with the existing setbacks. Joe confirmed they could based on the size of the house being built. Rebecca stated the homeowners could get a variance if there was a need. The board approved the recommendation 5-1
