	Clubhouse – Jason reported that they have a \$4K increase in revenue from prior year. There was		
	discussion on member demographics and reactions to the increase in prices. Jason commented on the		
	great team he has in the club house allowing him to focus on additional duties. There hasn't not been a		
	mechanic hired for the golf course specifically.		
	Golf Course – Garry was not in attendance but sent his report and Paul reported out some items they		
	discussed from a phone conversation. They are working on cleaning up the course from fallen sticks,		
	and streaming tree areas. They are attending to leaks and watering greens. We've installed new doors		
	on the barns with automatic pin pads to allow members to come and go. A new road sign will be		
	installed. The June outings went well and we're looking forward to the rest of the season.		
	Parks – Cliff reported that they are working on broken equipment. The interns have almost finished the		
	Miami's fort project. The electrical work at the concession stand is done along with the parking lot and

	etiquette rules, Barb spoke on behalf of suggestions from the public and the board gave		
	recommendations and comments. It is recommended to post that:		
	1) The courts be for pickleball play only.

	3) Players must have shoes on		

	4) No glass containers, pets or food on the courts.		
	It was suggested that we would name these Pickleball Court Etiquette. Paul mentioned she would pass		
	the information along to the Mayor and City's Attorney to provide any suggestions from them and it would be shared at the next meeting.		
	There was also discussion around any injuries and it was pointed out that the city is not liable for any injuries on city property.		
	Barb also asked if the courts had a designated address and Paul stated she would get with the city for		
	the address.		
	Barb made a final comment that she was going to work on a grant through the Health Department to		
	see if new courts could be built, there was a small discussion on space and additional funding		
	availability. Barb will keep the board informed of any major developments throughout the grant.
