First reading of **RESOLUTION NO 3-2025** A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL, CITY OF PERU INDIANA APPROVING THE REQUEST OF JAY VENTURES LLC, FOR TAX ABATEMENT, Tax abatement is being requested for new convenience store/gas station being built on the corner of US 24 and North Broadway. Councilperson Fisher stated that currently we receive \$48 annually for the property whereas with the abatement we would be receiving nearly \$10,800. Mr. Ewer questioned the amount of the abatement and how many abatements we currently have.

**ORDINANCE # 5, 2025 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 28, 2016** AN ORDINANCE AMENDING RATES, CHARGES, AND SERVICE CONDITIONS FOR THE CITY OF PERU MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS LOCATED AT THE PERU SERVICE AREA. Utility Superintendent Josh Chance stated that this increase is needed for the new mandate to replace lead service lines, including lead service lines from the meter pit to the first shut off inside a residential home. Josh estimated the replacement to cost roughly \$29,000,000. The Utilities have received a grant and several 0% interest loans to assist with the project.

A motion was made by Councilperson Huber, seconded by Councilperson Ulery to consider Ordinance 6-2025 vote 6-0 in favor

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**ORDINANCE** # **6-2025** AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2, 2024 Police Copy Fees, this amendment was to rescind all administrative fees that were listed in the ordinance.

A motion was made by Councilperson Fisher, seconded by Councilperson Ulery to consider Ordinance 6-2025 vote 6-0 in favor

**ORDINANCE #7-2025** AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 21-2024 AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A NORTH/SOUTH ROAD OUTSIDE THE CITY OF PERU WHEREAS; A PETITION TO VACATE a East/West Road bounded by the north by Lot 41 - Parcel # 52-08-16-303-001-000-015, bounded by the south by Lot 71 - Parcel # 52-08-16-303-010-001-015, bounded by the east by Farmland, bounded by the west by N Striker Road, commonly known as N Striker Road Lot 41 and N Striker Road Lot 71 Peru Indiana 46970. The amended ordinance previously passed is to correct the road description.

Moved by Councilperson Ulery, seconded by Councilperson Murphy, to suspend the rules and to adopt the ordinance in one meeting. Vote 6-0, **MOTION CARRIED**.
